Acceptance Guidance & Definition
CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS (C&D)

IS	IS NOT
Bulky debris that is not recyclable Painted, treated, or coated wood Wall coverings – Plaster, Drywall, etc. Styrofoam – and other bulky packaging Plumbing fixtures Non-asbestos insulation Windows & siding Roofing shingles and other coverings Plastic and other non-metal pipe Plastic and vinyl sheeting Floorings and Carpeting Hoses and tubing Tarps and Bale wrap Fiberglass and plastic vehicle body parts & cabs Unusable clothing Luggage Furniture Unusable large toys	Asbestos - (prior approval necessary) Household (kitchen & bathroom) garbage Recyclables – (recycle !!) Batteries – (recycle) Cardboard boxes - (recycle) Freon containing items- refrigerators, dehumidifiers, & AC units (recycle) Appliances - (bulk metal recycle) Tires - (remove from rims & recycle) Fuel tanks - (empty, cut both ends & bulk metal recycle) Electrical wire – (cut and recycle as scrap metal) Propane tanks- (remove valves & bulk metal recycle) Liquids or chemicals of any kind – (Clean Sweep) Paint – (Clean Sweep) Fluorescent lights, mercury, sodium lights (Clean Sweep) Ballasts, transformers (Clean Sweep) Clean wood – (ask for disposal location) Burn barrels or ash (not accepted)

C&D debris is subject to a \$95 per ton disposal fee.
 Disposal fees are payable by prepaid account, cash, or credit.









Delaware County SWMC Does NOT Accept:
Chemicals, or Hazardous Waste of any kind.

Clean Sweep is a household hazardous waste collection event offered in the fall of every year. **Registration is a must.** Check our website or call for this years information.
