	<b>Ashes &amp; Burn Barrels</b>
	<i>ashes from burn barrels, wood stoves, fireplaces, &amp; fire pits</i>
	<i>extinguish ashes &amp; bury on-site</i>
	<b>Hazardous or Toxic Materials</b>
	<i>defined by State, Federal &amp; DPW guidelines</i>
	<i>contract with hazardous waste hauler</i>
	<i>drop off during annual Clean Sweep event</i>
	<i>hazardous &amp; toxic materials include: fluorescent light bulbs &amp; ballasts; mercury lights &amp; bulbs; sodium lights &amp; bulbs; pesticides &amp; hazardous liquids; corrosives &amp; solvents; radioactive or regulated medical wastes</i>
	<b>Industrial Wastes</b>
	<i>contact SWMC for more info</i>
<b>Junk Vehicle, Body, or Chassis</b>	
<i>bring to scrap dealer</i>	
<b>Large Dead Animals &amp; Carcasses</b>	
<i>lime &amp; bury animals &amp; carcasses on property</i>	
<i>contract with rendering company or contact CCE for information on carcass composting</i>	
<i>Chronic Waste Disease carriers such as deer &amp; elk may be safely disposed of in the landfill. Please keep these carcasses separate from your regular garbage &amp; notify the scale operator that you have a carcass that needs to be landfilled. These animal carcasses should NOT be handled with your regular garbage.</i>	
<b>Liquids of Any Kind</b>	
<i>including paint that is still liquid (check for PaintCare drop off locations)</i>	
<i>contact your local waste water treatment facility</i>	
<b>Mixed Materials Loads</b>	
<i>all loads of waste &amp; recyclables MUST be delivered in appropriate separated categories</i>	
<b>Out-of-County Wastes</b>	
<i>wastes &amp; recyclables generated outside of Delaware County borders</i>	
<b>Radioactive Wastes</b>	
<i>all radioactive wastes, including those generated at home or as part of a medical procedure</i>	
<b>Regulated Medical Waste</b>	
<i>as defined by NYS DEC regulation</i>	
<i>including wastes generated at private medical offices as part of a hospital or other care facility</i>	
<b>Stumps &amp; Large Trees</b>	
<i>contact firewood processor or leave on-site</i>	
<b>Un-Bagged Yard Waste</b>	
<i>must be bagged</i>
